The Role

Work in an enjoyable, high energy environment. Your role is to safely serve high quality products to a great community of craft beer drinkers. The expectation is that customers will have an exceptional visit to the Ignite Brewing Company taproom. This includes, but not limited to:

- Greeting guests as they enter and being attentive
- Treating guests and coworkers with respect
- Correctly pouring beer and accurately filling/sealing growlers and crowlers
- Participate in staff meetings and ongoing training

Performance Requirements

- Check identification of guests in order to verify age requirements for purchase of alcohol
- Adhere to the safe alcohol serving guidelines and maintain ASK training
- Provide adequate availability
- Complete opening and closing duties for every shift
- Handle the POS system quickly and efficiently
- Maintain a clean environment by removing items on the floor, empty glasses, cleaning spills, etc.

Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED
- Consistently stand for the duration of a shift (up to 10 hours) while also bending, squatting, twisting, reaching, and lifting up to 40 pounds.
- Must be able to work independently or in a team
- Ability to take and pass a background check
- **Must be 21 years of age or older**
